**CIVIL COURT**

- All Civil Dockets are cancelled until April 13<sup>th</sup>.
- All Civil Trials are cancelled until April 13<sup>th</sup>.
- All Civil Pre-trials shall proceed by telephone. Contact each Division.
- **Civil Motion Hours** are as follows at the same regular times:  
March 20<sup>th</sup> Docket will be continued to April 21<sup>st</sup>  
March 27<sup>th</sup> Docket will be continued to April 27<sup>th</sup>  
April 3<sup>rd</sup> and April 10<sup>th</sup> Dockets will be continued to May 4<sup>th</sup>  
(Except for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Division, who will continue these dockets on May 1<sup>st</sup>)

**CRIMINAL COURT**

- All Criminal Dockets are cancelled until April 13<sup>th</sup>, **except** for in custody probation revocation hearings and motions for bond reductions; in custody violations of conditions of release and in custody show cause, which will remain on the regular Thursday/Friday schedules, unless specially schedule.
- Judges may attempt to schedule some motions by Video Conferencing at the Jail and will contact the lawyers to schedule.
- All In-Custody Video Arraignments shall be held on Thursdays.
- All Thursday Criminal Pre-trials shall be canceled, and they shall proceed telephonically or electronically until April 13<sup>th</sup>.
- All Criminal Evidentiary Hearings, both in and out of custody, will proceed as planned.
- All Competency Hearings will proceed as planned.
- All Out-of- Custody Criminal Trials are cancelled until April 13<sup>th</sup>.
- All In-Custody Criminal Trials will be rescheduled **unless** there is a speedy trial issue.
- **Criminal Motion Hours** as follows at the same regular times:  
March 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> Dockets will be continued to April 21<sup>st</sup>  
March 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> Dockets will be continued to April 27<sup>th</sup>  
April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Dockets will be continued to May 4<sup>th</sup>  
(Except for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Division who will continue these dockets to May 1<sup>st</sup>)

**JURY SERVICE**

- The March 2020 Grand Jury will continue to serve until the end of April.
