



NOTICE REGARDING FORCIBLE DETAINER ACTIONS
AUGUST 31, 2020

Effective August 25, 2020, Governor Andy Beshear's Executive Order 2020-700, requires:


A landlord shall provide any tenant at least 30 days' notice of the intent to evict from any residential premises for failure to pay rent.

During the time period of the 30-days' notice of the intent to evict from a residential premise for failure to pay rent, the landlord of the residential premises and the tenant or leaseholder of the residential premises shall meet and confer or attempt to meet and confer, and the notice of the intent to evict shall request the meet and confer and provide the tenant with the landlord's contact information.


This Notice is subject to change based upon further Executive Order entered by the Governor of the Commonwealth or by Order of the Kentucky Supreme Court.
