



# Family Court Rules

## Substantive Changes

### Rule 202. E-Filing

E-Filing shall be the preferred (read mandatory) method of filing for all divisions of the Fayette Family Court.

Exceptions: DNA, DV, Status, Sealed Cases

### Rule. 701 Motion Hour Deadlines

Motions: 10 Days (Wed. 4 pm)  
Responses: 4 Days (Tues. 4 pm)  
Reply: Noon the day prior to MH

Plead in a manner which allows the Court to potentially rule on the pleadings.

### Families in Transition

No Longer Required. Will still be ordered in case-by-case basis as court deems appropriate.

Likely before any motion practice regarding modifications to custody, timesharing, school choice or other major kid issues.

## Other Minor Changes

### Rule 3.

GAL ordered in Adoptions and TPRs to be completed with prior GAL name

### Rule 4.

Agreed Order Procedure for DV cases.

### Rule. 7

Signature Requirements for uncontested dissolutions per statute with exception of settlement agreement.
