PART II Expungement Basics







Expungement is a court-ordered process by which the legal records related to certain charges are sealed or erased.



WHAT CAN BE EXPUNGED?

Misdemeanor, violation, or traffic infraction convictions & dismissed charges

Certain Class D felony convictions

Dismissed felony charges

Felony charges sent to grand jury that have not resulted in indictment

Acquittals

Certain juvenile records



WHAT CANNOT BE EXPUNGED?

Civil matters

• Example – contract lawsuit, small claims cases, etc.

DVOs & other Family Court actions

• BUT dismissed DVO <u>cases</u> can be expunged

Federal convictions

Very limited expungement possibilities

Parking tickets



OVERVIEW OF EXPUNGEMENT PROCESS

Petition or application is filed in same court/county as original case;

Hearing or appearance at criminal motion hour;

Prosecutors may object;

Expungement is *not* guaranteed;

If judge grants expungement, agencies have 60 days from order to seal records



Dismissals and acquittals are FREE

\$40 Certificate of Eligibility fee for all convictions

FEES

Misdemeanor convictions - \$100 per case number

Felony conviction - \$50 filing fee, then \$250 expungement fee if the expungement order is entered (the \$250 fee can be paid in installments for up to 18 months)

Filing fees can possibly be waived via IFP motion/order if client has limited income and resources



HELP WITH EXPUNGEMENT FEES

LABG partners with Goodwill & LFUCG to have expungement clinics

• If a client attends a Goodwill or LFUCG expungement clinic, the client may become eligible for financial assistance to pay for some of the client's expungement expenses.

Some managed care Medicaid companies also help with fees

Anthem Kentucky Medicaid pays \$540 for expungement fees.



Certificates of Eligibility



CERTIFICATE OF ELIGIBILITY

Required for every petition for expungement of a conviction

- 1.Get form AOC-RU-009 at https://documents/RU009.pdf or https://dpa.ky.gov/home/clients/expungement/
- 2.Client needs to complete form
- 3.Check or money order to KY State Treasurer or online payment of \$40
- 4. Mail to AOC in Frankfort or submit online



CERTIFICATE OF ELIGIBILITY (continued)

Client receives certification – 3 parts

- 1. **Certification Notice** Lists each charge and KSP's opinion on whether charges are expungable
- 2. **AOC CourtNet** Criminal history record
- 3. KSP Criminal History Report

Timeframe – Certification expires in 30 days.

KRS 431.079 indicates that Certificates are not authority.

Dismissed Charges & Acquittals



EXPUNGEMENTS OF DISMISSED CHARGES & ACQUITTALS

Starting July 15, 2020

If a court enters an order of acquittal of criminal charges against a person; OR

Enters an order dismissing <u>with</u> prejudice all criminal charges in a case against a person, and not in exchange for a guilty plea to another charge;

The court shall order the record expunged upon the expiration of 30 days



DISMISSED CHARGES & ACQUITTALS (continued)

For dismissals and acquittals prior to July 15, 2020, you can petition for an expungement when:

- 60 days have passed since the order of acquittal or dismissal with prejudice by the court
- 2. For charges <u>dismissed without prejudice</u>:
 - 3 years for <u>felony</u> dismissals without prejudice
 - 1 year for misdemeanor dismissals without prejudice

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FAILURE TO INDICT / "BOUND OVER"

- **Bound Over.** Felony cases that have been "bound over" to the Grand Jury and do not result in an indictment are eligible for dismissal and expungement <u>6 months</u> after the case is "bound over."
- No Hearing.
- **Service**. Expungement petition must be served upon the County or Commonwealth's Attorney. KRS 431.076(3)(b).
 - o Prosecution has 90 days to respond. KRS 431.076(3)(b)(2).
 - If a response is not filed in 90 days, the Court "shall dismiss the charges without prejudice and order the expunging of the records." KRS 431.076(3)(b)(3).
- **Time Frame.** If a response is filed, and if 90 days after the filing date an indictment has not been issued, the Court "shall dismiss without prejudice" and issue an order expunging. KRS 431.076(3)(b)(4).

Having a felony on my record has made it incredibly difficult to get a good job. It's nearly impossible for me to have a real career because most employers won't consider you when you're a convicted felon. This in turn makes me feel stressed about going into job interviews knowing that my application will probably be rejected once they run a background check. It takes a toll on my mental health figuring out how to support my family with limited employment opportunities.

f. If expungement is granted, how will this make a difference in your life?

If expungement is granted it will be life changing. I will finally be able to get a career that will allow me to provide for my family and have stability in my life. I won't be ashamed to apply for jobs because my record will be wiped clean. My long-term goal is to be a social worker, and having a clean record will allow me to complete the necessary schooling I need to achieve this goal.

g. Is there anything you would like the Court to know as it considers whether to grant or deny this Application?

I can honestly say that I'm not the same person I was back then, but when employers see the felony conviction on my record, they make a snap judgment about me based solely on my mistakes. I want to be seen for the progress I've made in turning my life around—not for my past mistakes. This is the final hurdle in putting my past behind me.


