May 20, 2026

There was one order of business: consideration of the 2026–2027 FCBA Operating Budget.

Mary Patton made a motion to accept the 2026–2027 budget. Anna Fletcher seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

President Garcia asked Dana to include discussion of the UK Bourbon Law Event and the AWP leftover funds on the June agenda.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

Director's Report – July 15, 2026

Membership renewal for the 2026–2027 bar year opened in April, and we currently have **621 members renewed**.

The Association had a successful spring with **Law Day** on May 5 and the **Annual Bench & Bar CLE** on June 24. Thank you to the many volunteers, speakers, sponsors, and attendees who helped make both events a success. The Bench & Bar CLE was recorded, and the popular "**Transy Book Heist**" presentation will be released later this summer as an on-demand CLE available for purchase.

Oral history interviews remain ongoing, and each completed interview is being added to the **Centennial** webpage, creating a lasting digital archive of the people and stories that have shaped our Association. Committee planning also continues as we prepare for the September 17 Centennial Celebration.

The **Young Lawyers Section** recently launched its annual School Supply Drive with a summer happy hour and will continue collecting donations through **August 14**. YLS members will also volunteer with **Legal Aid of the Bluegrass** at the **Expungement Clinic** on **August 20**. Additionally, the Section has voted to provide the recorded **Senate Bill 50** CLE free of charge to current FCBA Young Lawyers Section members as an added membership benefit.

To further educate the public, FCBA will record a podcast on **July 22** featuring Board Member **Bethany Davenport** discussing **Senate Bill 50** from a public perspective—focusing on what Kentuckians should know about the new probate laws and when they should seek legal advice.

The **Bankruptcy Section** is exploring expanded programming with the goal of offering quarterly educational or networking events. The **Federal Practice Section**, following the tremendous success of its inaugural meeting, is planning its next program for September after the Centennial Celebration. The **Women's Law Association** will welcome **Habitat for Humanity** for its July meeting at Frank & Dino's on **July 28**.

FCBA will also have a presence at the **UK CLE 18th Biennial Consumer Bankruptcy Law Conference** on **August 6–7** at The Campbell House, providing another opportunity to connect with attorneys and promote Association membership and programming.

Carey Howard, District Court Administrator, will retire on July 31 after years of dedicated service. There is a celebration on the 5th Floor of the District Courthouse all day with comments at 2 p.m.

As we move through the summer, the Association continues to build momentum through quality programming, active sections, meaningful public outreach, and exciting progress toward our Centennial Celebration.

CKLRS Program Update July 2026

Since our last meeting, the LRS has generated \$3504.30 in referral and member fees.

There are 54 open cases from active attorneys on the service. Case status Inquiries were sent via email, mail, and LRS portal.

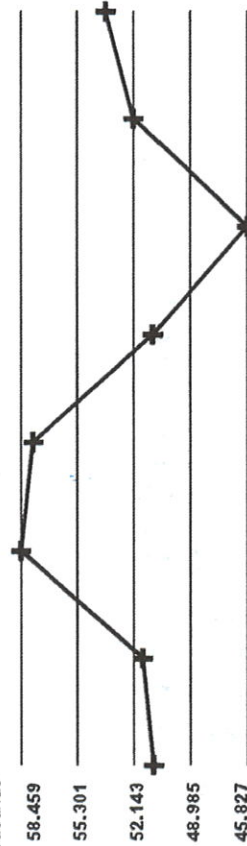
